CERTIFICATION OF KHV FREE COMPARTMENT

The Israeli Veterinary Services (Ministry of Agriculture & Rural Development) hereby certifies and designates the Koi on Demand Koi carp (*Cyprinus carpio koi*) breeding and growing facility, situated at Tarom as a KHV free compartment.

This designation meets the preconditions laid down by the OIE [Aquatic Animal Health Code (2007) Chapter 2.1.17, Article 2.1.17.5] as well as those specified by the European Union [Council Directive 2006/88/EC of 24 October 2006 (on animal health requirements for aquaculture and products thereof, and on the prevention and control of certain diseases in aquatic animals)].

This certification is based on the following:

- 1) Since the beginning of production (January, 2007), no suspicious of KHVD were ever recorded in the Koi on Demand breeding and growing facility.
- 2) No sort of vaccination is being practiced in the Koi on Demand production facility.
- 3) Basic Biosecurity conditions, as defined by the Israeli Veterinary Services (February 4th, 2007), have been continuously met since December 2009.
- 4) Targeted Surveillance by the Israeli Veterinary Services has been in place since December 2009, with no detection of KHVD or KHV antibodies.

The present certificate is valid for 1 year from the date of issuing.
